EVOLVEA: J2EE Alfresco Developer Pathway

This practical pathway is designed to introduce first time Alfresco users who will be involved with an Alfresco project and want to continue a learning pathway to becoming an Alfresco developer or expert.

This self-paced practical course is designed to introduce you to the technology of Alfresco Enterprise Content Management. Through a combination of self-paced learning sessions, demonstrations, customization company solutions and exercises you can begin to familiarize yourself with Alfresco technology, and gain an insight into its architecture and deployment options.

Pre-Requisites

The pathway can be taken without any previous Alfresco experience and does not require any other courses as a pre-requisite. It acts as a necessary to understand Alfresco environment and its architecture.

It is a requirement that you understand XML and are able to edit XML files for configuration of the system. You should be familiar with basic system administration of an operating system such as Linux or Windows and have:

- some experience in the development of J2EE applications,
- using the Eclipse development tools
- knowledge of some Spring framework, Struts, language, Javascript, CSS.
- knowledge of SQL language

Pathway Objectives

The pathway will allow participants to understand what it is possible to do with the Alfresco system and to make appropriate and informed decisions about when and how to deploy the technology.

In order for participants to understand how development is carried out we also look at the alternative options of configuring, customizing and developing with Alfresco.

At the end of this pathway you should be able to:

- Understand the components of an Alfresco ECM system and their interactions
- Create and manipulate content in the repository
- Understand how Alfresco manages content and metadata
- Understand the Alfresco content model
- Create custom object types and aspects
- Describe the Alfresco security model
- Configure users, groups, and roles
- Understand repository configuration
- Compiling and delivery Alfresco application on most important application servers
